The VAULT400 permits data to be available and accessible at all times for immediate online recovery. It backs up an entire organization's business- critical data from multi-plant or satellite offices without the need for additional hardware. "It is safe. It is off-site. It is reliable. It more cost effective than high availability solutions," Kandrac said.

William da Cunha, an EVault vice-president, said United Computer Group has "demonstrated a high level of knowledge and experience with regard to the market" and they can provide strategic market growth. EVault is a market leader in online backup and recovery systems, which gives United Computer Group's VAULT400 an edge that no other online retrieval service has, Kandrac said.
